Members of the Royal Australian Air Force and the Thai Air Force came to speak to students about the current exercise, Pitch Black. Students were very engaged and asked thoughtful questions. Pitch Black is the biggest exercise for the Air Force which has over 4000 Defence people visiting Darwin. They participate in training exercises to better support our allied countries. One question was, "why is it called Pitch Black?" The answer is simply that in the beginning they would only train at night, hence there was no light. Pilots and other crew members must train at night, just as people learning to drive need to practise at night.


